The Palm Springs Preservation Foundation hosted a celebration Saturday to honor the establishment of Casa Cody Inn as a class-one historical site. The first of the structures that comprise the inn were built in the early 1900s, while other houses came later. The Casa Cody Hotel and apartments were built in the 1930s.

Present for the celebration were Palm Springs Mayor Pro Tem Ginny Foat, preservation foun-

dation members, inn owners Frank Tysen and Theresa Hayes, as well as nine descendents of the original inn owner Harriet Cody.

Some guests took a self-guided tour of the property.

Foat presented the owners with framed documentation recognizing the property as a historic site.
