Dear Dr. Ready,

In our letter of June 6, 2019, the Palm Springs Preservation Foundation (PSPF) awarded the city of Palm Springs a grant of \$50,000 to support the city's fundraising efforts for the restoration of the Plaza Theatre.

The sole condition of the PSPF grant read as follows:

Should the city's fundraising efforts prove insufficient for the restoration of the Plaza Theatre, PSPF requests the return of this grant money.

To that end, PSPF asks that the city confirm, in writing, that fundraising efforts continue with the goal of the Plaza Theatre's restoration, especially in view of the city's current financial hardships.

The PSPF board of directors still views the restoration of the theater as vitally important to the Palm Springs community. We also have a fiduciary responsibility to confirm that the city remains committed to this effort.
