

# Demolition may be stalled at school

**PALM SPRINGS** — The Palm Springs High School Administration Building is set to be leveled this summer to make way for a new Performing Arts Building.

But preservationists and school officials are at odds over the midcentury modern building.

The project may be stalled as the Palm Springs Preservation Foundation fights to save the 55-year-old building designed by Donald Wexler and Richard Harrison.

The proposed building is expected to have arches similar to Ramon Academy and include a new band room, small practice rooms, an audio recording studio, changing rooms for the band and Black Box Theater performers, student restrooms and instrument and costume storage for theater productions.
