## Demolition may be stalled at school

PALM SPRINGS — The Palm Springs High School Administration Building is set to be leveled this summer to make way for a new Performing Arts Building.

But preservationists and school officials are at odds over the midcentury mod-

ern building.

The project may be stalled as the Palm Springs Preservation Foundation fights to save the 55-year-old building designed by Donald Wexler and Richard Harrison.

The proposed building is expected to have arches similar to Ramon Academy and include a new band room, small practice rooms, an audio recording studio, changing rooms for the band and Black Box Theater performers, student restrooms and instrument and costume storage for theater productions.
