Subject: Palm Springs City Hall Historic Landscape Plan

Dear Steven,

On January 8, 2024 the Palm Springs Preservation Foundation's board of directors voted unanimously to support your proposal to create an historically-accurate landscape plan for the Palm Springs City Hall site. As you know, PSPF championed the designation of the entire city hall site starting in 2009 when the city proposed an ill-advised plan to rewick the parking lot that would have blocked historic sight lines. In 2012, PSPF's efforts culminated in a significant success when the city council formally designated the entire city hall site as historic. Hence, it is appropriate that PSPF support any efforts to return the landscape to its original design.

To that end, we are forwarding you a grant check in the amount of \$1,300.00. We recognize that a portion of the grant will be expended on securing and reproducing historic documents and imagery. This grant is subject to the following conditions:

1. That PSPF is authorized to make an announcement regarding this grant to publicize our grant program; and,
2. That all PSPF funds are properly expended by July 31, 2024.

We will consider your redemption of the attached check as acceptance of all conditions and would ask that you provide periodic updates on the progress of the project.
