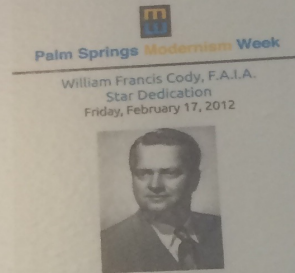
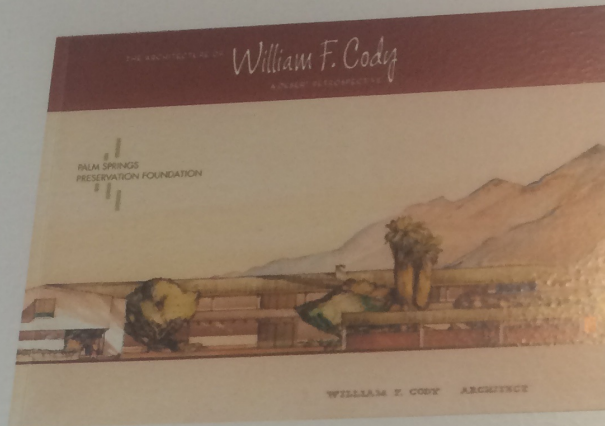


Palm Springs Preservation Foundation recognized at a William F. Cody exhibition in Los Angeles, July 2016



August 29: Within two months of his mother's death, William F. Cody passed away.

1979

Posthumously, Bill received the Golden Palm Award for Excellence in the design for St. Theresa Church, presented to Wini. George Hasslein delivered a tribute to Bill at the ceremony.

April 16 – 20: "An Exhibit of the Work of William Cody, F.A.I.A." was displayed in the Arch Gallery, California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo. A. Quincy Jones wrote the foreword in the booklet accompanying the exhibit: "Bill Cody was a spirited, generous man as well as innovative in his architecture. All of this certainly comes through the character of his work."

1981

July 1: Winifred Cody died.

2004

November: Palm Springs Preservation Foundation organized The Architecture of William F. Cody, A Desert Retrospective. A Tribute Journal showcasing various Cody works was published by the Foundation.

2012

February 17: Star Dedication Ceremony to honor William Francis Cody presented by the City of Palm Springs. A sidewalk square at the corner of Palm Canyon and Baristo Road is officially dedicated.
